On my site medlink-uk.net homepage, the Vetmedlink FLV file link works fine in Explorer 8 and Firefox 4.

In Firefox 3.6.17 it only runs once then produces a "200, stream not found ..." error when you click the link a second or third time. (this happens on 3 different computers in two different locations)

It will only work again if the cache is cleared.

Any ideas?

Also can you select which video player it uses or is Flowplayer the default player?

Also is Pretty Photo just Sexy Lightbox with the ability to play FLV files, or are there other differences?

Try to open your FLV file in FireFox 3 browser. If the next error appears:

Content Encoding Error

It is problem with FireFox configuration. The solution how to fix it can be found here. After changing configuration press "Ctrl + F5" on the page with FLV video.
