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You can create new module instance, set "Open on load" parameter to "Only once", choose "Inline content" value in "Choose type" drop-down, leave empty "Link text" parameter, type text which you want to display in lightbox into "Content" textarea, set "Menu Assignment -> Menus" parameter to "All". After this users will see necessary text in popup.

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Hi there!

We bought Ari Pretty Photo few days ago. I am trying to make a popup to appear on entering the site. I did everything you described, but it does not work. You can see it here:

There is a small "test" link in the footer of the page which opens the test popup and should open automaticali on enter the page. But it does not work.

I turned off almost everything else to see if it interferes with some other module (superfish menu and this fade in on the background) - no change. Looks like `$("#mylink").click();` method is not working. I did another test: I put a link inside the footer test link then I added `jQuery("#myTstLink").click();` - not working. It does not trigger the link.

Why not just call the method that is attached to the click event on the link and skip the link? I tried to find how to call the popup directly, but the .js file is minimized so not readable...

Please advise me.
