'Language' flag on JED means that the module and the plugins support Joomla! internalization approach which helps to use different languages for module and plugins parameters pages. About your requirement, we have updated the module and now it provides ability to use different CSV files with descriptions for different languages. For this create CSV files with file name in the following format: ..csv where is base file name without extension which is indicated in 'Description file' parameter, is tag of active site language. For example, if active language is 'Russian' and value of 'Description file' parameter is 'arifancybox.csv' create file with name arifancybox.ru-RU.csv. Updated extension can be download in 'Member Area', after this upgrade 'ARI Fancybox' module that enable new feature.
