I'm having problems with my web site host in that sometimes when I upload new images and then create a new web page with them, the web page fails to load.

Mozilla Firefox just shows a blank page; IE10 says the web site is closed for maintenance or the web page has a programming error.

There's no way it can be your extension. I suspect that the host site is having write permission errors and they are investigating.

The problem can occur following the upload of a new images folder or if I attempt to change the size of the thumbnails for an existing set of images on an existing web page.

There are 2626 ARI thumbnails in the cache folder, I don't suppose there might be a problem because of this number and, at the moment, I'm reluctant to try deleting them all.

Any suggestions gratefully received.

I assume I can delete them all. The next time somebody views a corresponding page they will be regenerated. In the Joomla backend, I tend to copy articles, revise all the parameters and then view the results in the Frontend. I may well then adjust the thumbnail size parameter (maybe several times) until I get the look I want. So, does your extension rewrite the thumbnails or delete and recreate them or not delete them? I don't mind which, but if I'm increasing the number of thumbnails by doing this, I need to remember to delete cache every now and again. Many thanks for your help.
