
Ligning images in Joomla 3.3

I've been using ARI Photo Gallery very successfully for some time now, but having upgraded from Joomla 2.5 to Joomla 3.3 (plus Photo Gallery), I find that the images no longer align as I would like.

The problem seems to be caused by the different lengths of the image titles loaded from the csv titles file.

This one shows the top of the images misaligned, the space between images varies and the text doesn't "wrap" with its image.

The impression given is that too much text causes this problem, but there's nothing I can do about it other than to remove the titles.csv file and insert the text underneath each image giving me a lot more work!

Add the following CSS rules to a site template CSS file (for example to /templates/jsn_nuru_free/css/template.css file) and clean browser's cache:

TABLE.ari-pg-table TR {vertical-align:top;}

TABLE.ari-pg-table TD {text-align: center;}

It should help.
