| The component stores quiz results based on user id. If share account is used, the extension can't split quiz results. If you guest account, the extension can't identify a user and can't know what results necessary to show to guest user.   |
| PS: The extension restore previous quiz session if it is not completed that quiz session will not lost if a browser crashed, internet connection is dropped and etc.   |
