We have investigated this issue. You can resolve this in two ways:

---

1) Login to your Joomla backend, open 'Components->OpenSEF->Configuration->Features' page and set 'Enforce Canonical URL' to 'No'. It removes redirect from <http://www.laramyk.com/index.php> to <http://www.laramyk.com/> and all should work fine.

2) You can exclude the component from OpenSEF handling. For this login to your Joomla backend, open 'Components->OpenSEF->Configuration->Components' page and check 'Exclude' checkbox for 'ARI Quiz'.
