>>>perfect when I put arabic characters, but really too big when I put occidental letters (and I need to use both -arabic & occidental)

The ideal solution could be to be able to apply a different css style from the backend.

Hope I'm clear enough?

I presume the solution is becoming to be an important hack...that could be integrated in the future in the pack? who knows... this arabic-characters-size problem is very common for webmasters dealing with arabic fonts :-)
