Not sure if this helps you out, but there is a work around.
Set the value of the question to "100"
Then set the answer values (under the "Free Text Question" question type) as $A=1 \%, B=5 \%, C=10 \%$, etc
I don't think you'll be able to include the \$MaxScore or \$PercentScore in the Text and Mail Result Templates. Might limit using some other fields in the results, but I'm not sure. However it sounds like you might not need them anyway, since \$UserScore will show the points perfectly and you can just manually add the \$MaxScore to the result templates if you need it to appear.

Hopefully that helps.
