We use some generi usernames and I need this to be forced to prompt before test with username. I have custom done mine to omit email and they use a drop down box to select location. This worked fine before turning on the SSO. Is there some code I can use to not auto fill this, or make it prompt as before. I have my SSO addon to not fill any form or name or password fields, so this shouldn't be caused from that plugin.

If the following code is commented, the extension will not populate "name" and "email" fields with previous values for new quiz sessions:

```
$data = AriUtils::getParam($_COOKIE, 'aq_email', '');  
$data = AriUtils::getParam($_COOKIE, 'aq_name', '');
```

The extension shows the form only for guest users, if you want to change this behaviour see the following code in /components/com_arquiz/controllers/quiz.php file:

```
if ($user->get('id') == 0 && $quiz->Anonymous != 'Yes')  
{  
    $formView = $this->getSubView('guestform', 'quizform');  
}
```

If want to show the form always then use the following code in /components/com_ariquiz/controllers/quiz.php file:

```
$formView = $this->getSubView('guestform', 'quizform');
```

instead of:

```

I have commented out the Cookie part in

```

I have modified the guestform.xml to add a drop down box to select location. Updated Language files and so forth to correspond to this, as well as add Params so can set variable in templates to pull this location data. This was working before we turned on SSO. My question is it possible to omit and not even read Joomla's user ID and so forth jus take the input from the username location form presented each time at beginnng of test. Because it is still

pulling the logged in user and not populating the Location variable at all.

Thanks for any info, we begin company wide testing with over 30 test and I need to be able to pull these variables from the guestform
