If you want to center timer content, add the following CSS rules to a site template CSS file:

```
TABLE.aq-timer TD {text-align:center;}  
TABLE.aq-timer .aq-time {display:inline-block;}
```

All text labels can be changed in language INI files. Labels for timer are located in /language/en-GB/en-GB.com_ariquiz.ini file:

```
COM_ARIQUIZ_DATE_HOURLSHORT="hr"  
COM_ARIQUIZ_DATE_MINUTESHORT="min"  
COM_ARIQUIZ_DATE_SECONDSSHORT="sec"
```
