Love the quiz module (as you have probably guessed), however I must be doing something wrong when it comes to the multiple choice questions and giving out a \% of the total marks. For example, if the user say selects 2 out of 3 options that are correct, I would want them to get 2 out of the total 3 marks available.

I have assigned the \% for each answer in the question, however it still does not seem to be working. The user has to either get them all right for the marks, or one wrong option and they are getting no marks.

I am assuming this is something that I am doing wrong so it would be helpful if you could explain my mistake.
