It also shows problem connecting to the server error sometimes, but from the very next save it starts working again

This is the complete statistics today..

On IE9

Tried 20 times.. 16 times it shown the "loading please wait" error and 6 times "problem connecting to the server" error

On Firefox

Tried 15 times no errors

On Chrome

Tried 10 times, no errors

One another point worth mentioning... I created a page in Joomla as an introduction to the exam. It also fails to load in in IE..

Not a big prob, coz I am not using it to create pages, but just for the exam content... Is the error have any relevance with the ARI Quiz error?
