About "auto-rotate" problem from your previous post, set "Continuos" parameter to "Yes" if you want to show first (or last) item when last (or first) item is reached. You can also set "Opposite" parameter to "Yes", it defines way in what the slider will scroll item from last item to first item and vise versa.
