The module provides ability to specify from what categories (sections) articles will be selected. It also provides ability to specify additional parameters like to include frontend articles or not, IDs of articles which will be ignored and others. The module can be embed into an article with help "Content - Load Module" plugin or with help "Content - ARI Easy Slider" plugin which is included into extension's package.

"ARI Easy Slider" module can be used without plugin if you want to show it in site template module position (this is standard Joomla! feature). If you want to embed the module into an article, install "Content - ARI Easy Slider" plugin, enable it and place the next code into an article:

{arieasyslider moduleId="MODULE_ID"}{/arieasyslider}

Where MODULE_ID is ID of "ARI Easy Slider" module which you can find in Joomla! module manager. For example if

you want to load "ARI Easy Slider" module with ID equals to 45, the code will look like:

{arieasyslider moduleId="45"}{/arieasyslider}
