Set "SQL -> SQL query" parameter to the next value:

```
SELECT
  user_id,
  profile_key,
  profile_value
FROM
  #__user_profiles
ORDER BY
  user_id,ordering
```

Set "SQL -> Graph transformation -> Enable" to "Yes", "SQL -> Graph transformation -> X axis column" to "profile_key", "SQL -> Graph transformation -> Y axis column" to "user_id" and "SQL -> Graph transformation -> Value column" to "profile_value" value.

I want a table that shows name, email, adress1, adress2, city and fonenumbers. I made a SQL query in access, but this does not work in Ari. Do you hav a solution? TRIM(BOTH "" FROM profile_value) AS profile_value
```

Instead of:

```
profile_value
```
