If your file is saved in UTF-8 encoding, it doesn't require to specify encoding in "CSV -> File encoding" parameter, but if your file is saved in non-UTF8 encoding (for example ISO-8859-1) then it requires to specify encoding which is used in your file in the parameter (for example ISO-8859-1).
