In the results page the following columns sort in ascending / descending order by clicking the heading

Place, Name, bib No., Gender Place, Gender, Category Place, Category, Swim Tlme, T1 Time, Bike Time, T2 Time and Club. These all work perfectly.

Swim Time, T1 Time, Bike Time, T2 Time, Run TIme, Chip Time are not sorting into ascending or descending order very well.

Also is there any way of fine tuning the search function ? (i.e. when searching M (male) only we are getting F (female) results as well)
