I am displaying a list of e-mail addresses in a data table, specifically so that I can copy them for use in a distribution list. The e-mail addresses are being automatically formatted with a "mailto:" link, which causes the output to include extra information in this format for each line: `// +addy83483+"; //-->`

How can I stop it from formatting the e-mail addresses as links, so that my output can be text-only?
