Hello,

Do you want to covert a value with version number to a hyperlink? If yes then you use "Columns settings -> Format" parameter in module settings. For example if column which contains version numbers has name VersionNumber then populate "Columns settings -> ID" parameter with VersionNumber value and enter the following value in "Column settings -> Format" parameter:

Version {\$value}

Check it out here: website.com/#version=1.1" Now when people click on this link they should get redirected to our version history site. But instead of showing all entrys like it would normally do, it only shows the version stated in the link.

If you show data from a database, it is possible to use request variables in "WHERE" clause of SQL query. For example if you want to select data from a table where value of VersionId field equals to value of "vld" request variable (link of a page will look like site.com/mypage.html?vld=115), query will look like:

```
SELECT
*
FROM
tbl
WHERE
VersionId = {$REQUEST:vld}
```
