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If you want to show data from a CSV file (not MS Excel file), upload it to your server, set "Choose source type" parameter to "CSV" value in module settings, enter path to the CSV file in "CSV -> Path to CSV file" parameter. For example if path to file is /reports/data.csv then populate the parameter with reports/data.csv value. Set "Server side pagination" parameter to "No", it doesn't work for data from CSV files.
