Hello,

If you want to change text color for the second column, add the following CSS rule to "CSS Styles" parameter in module settings:

```
#{id} TBODY TD.ari-tbl-col-1 {  
  color: red;  
}
```

for the 3rd column, add the following code:

```
#{id} TBODY TD.ari-tbl-col-2 {  
  color: green;  
}
```

The extension doesn't support ability to merge columns.
