Thank you for the transformation script. This works correct using this code:
{ \$value|date_format:d.m.Y}
to make sure that the " " are not shown in the field.

But it impacts the sort rule and it's not anymore the loading rule:
ORDER BY
datum DESC
It then sorts with the new value from left to right d ... m ... Y

Maybe you would have any hint for a workaround to have the date following our rule "d.m.Y" and to sort by date and not by text?

A quick test using Type "Date (dd/mm/YYYY)" instead of "Date" helps to load with SQL loading sort but the column with the date is not anymore sortable. Icons are available but inactive. If I restart using another column then I have no possibility to go back to the original sort (use the sort of the column with the date).

If you want to disable sorting for specific column then open data source settings page, find "Columns settings" section and enter column name or zero-based column index in "Columns settings -> ID" parameter and set "Columns settings -> Sortable" parameter to "No".
