I created the INI file in the image folder. (It was originally in the Joomla language file named "ariimageslider.sys.ini") But after following the instructions and placing the code:

It would not work. (I read a previous ARI-Soft forum and made sure that all text was in small letters, so font size should not be the problem).

3) I would much rather have the captions in the INI file inside Joomla language file just exactly the way the developer designed it but it's not working for me so I'll be happy to take it anyway I can.
