"This was already enabled on the server however was disabled for this website due to the php.ini file in the root directory. I have disabled this override so your website uses the main PHP file."

"OK, great, cheers!
Doesn't seem to have fixed my issues though..."

"I would recommend making sure you don't have any php.ini files in this directory or any directories within the folder you are running the script, if there is then remove these. I can confirm from what I can see though this isn't disabled on the actual server side configuration file."
