Okay. This is what I'm talking about see the lower right-hand corner of the page. You'll see that when a smaller image overlays a larger one, the larger one still shows beneath the smaller one because the smaller one isn't re-sized to completely cover the container area (or rather, the container isn't re-sized to fit the image). Similar problem with vertical vs. horizontal pictures.
