INI file should be located in folder with image, in your case this is /images/kids-books-2/ folder. Content of INI file should look like:
book-dare-to-dream.png="Dare to Dream" book-hot-issues-cool-choices.png="Hot Issues, Cool Choices"
book-dare-to-dream.png="kids-books/dare-to-dream.html" book-hot-issues-cool-choices.png="kids-books/hot-issues-cool-choices.html"
PS: One note, file names are case-insensitive.
