
"google" engine don't open in Chrome 20 and IE8

Plugin is great, thank you so much.

But I can't make it work in Google Chrome 20 AND IE 8, and it works fine in FF 15, IE 9, Opera 12 and Safari 5.

Site is in Serbian language, and there is a link at the bottom of both articles, with book icon on the left, which says "Prelistajte knjigu online", meaning "Online book reading". That link opens JCE MediaBox popup, which loads articles with only plugin snippet code, and in totally blank and empty Joomla template.
