Thanks, but the document is on site's server. Actually, it's a shared web hosting, so maybe that's the reason why it's too slow. I liked to use Ari Docs with Google viewer, so there was tools, a visible scrollbar and automatic download link. Furthermore, it's impossible to put files on open services like Slideshare or Issuu and to embed it in articles, because most of the documents are restricted to some users (i.e. not public documents). And it's difficult to put them on external server, like Dropbox, because these special users have to put documents on the server. Well, it seems that there is no way except to use iframe as doc viewer engine and to insert a manual download link.
