I have just updated ARI Magnifier and installed ARI Smart Book on a site. So far so good - it imported the old PDF catalogue and I was able to create and use a book with the contents however
When I wish to select a file to download as a PDF catalogue I can select the local file but the "Upload PDF" button does nothing.
I have cleared the browser cache as this is often the reason for various Joomla buttons not working, but it makes no difference.
I have looked for a "Enable download button" option in the configuration but it seems that that's not the problem.
Any ideas?
