The extension can create books based on images from the selected folder(s). For this when create a book select "Images" value in "Pages are created from" drop-down, open "Pages source" tab on book settings page and populate "Directories" parameter with relative path(s) to folder(s) with images. For example if want to show images from /images/my_book folder, populate the parameter with the following value:
images/my_book
Images can be uploaded via Joomla! media manager.
