Versions 1.0.6 - 1.0.8 are incompatible with some other extensions:

- PRI Animation (modules appear only after page scroll; with version 1.0.5 they appear on page load)

All versions of ARI Layer Slider are incompatible with Google Maps by Reumer (positioning and style of ARI slider are broken). The author Mike Reumer looked into the problem and told me that this is because of incompatibility of ARI extension.

if I disable Googlemaps by Reumer, slider works correctly, but look at the next link in example 2)

Updating to 1.0.8 doesn't solve the issue on this website

2) <http://79.165.111.198/lexicon/ru/> - Plugin version 1.0.8 and everything works fine with the same plugins activated and the same settings.

Unfortunately I cannot show you issue with PRI Animation because there is version 1.0.5 now and if I update to 1.0.8 it would affect the live site at <http://lexic-on.ru/ru>

But as you can see 1.0.8 works smoothly at <http://79.165.111.198/lexicon/ru/>

It seems like not all code is loaded at <http://lexic-on.ru/en> which affects other plugins. But I can't figure out why everything is ok with <http://79.165.111.198/lexicon/ru/>

Here's what the Googlemaps plugin wrote:

Hello Alex,

I see the difference between the pages with and without map. The slider has a different position somehow when the map is on the page.:

position: absolute;

left: 0px;

top: 295px;

Instead of:

position: relative;

This is not generated on the page, but is set by javascript when the page is loaded.

I think you need help from the developer of the slider on how this is set and how you can solve the problem.

I hope he can help you.

Conflict occurs with map extension because it uses MooTools javascript library. "ARI Layer Slider" is not compatible with MooTools. Main Joomla! javascript library for frontend is jQuery. MooTools is legacy and it will be removed in next versions of Joomla!

The extension will work fine with a map extension which uses jQuery library.

Map extension loads MooTools library, if open HTML source of the page, you will see that MooTools is loaded before scripts of map extension. On another site you use v. 1.0.8, it removes legacy Joomla! HTML code.

As I see you did not look into problem in details because what you say is wrong. I tried version 1.0.8 on both sites with the same extensions and same settings just right now. You say that 1.0.8 solves the issue with MooTools but you are WRONG - I have the same issue.

So, please help me to find the REAL source of the problem. The extension is paid so I think I can hope for some REAL support and not just formal replies.

It is not a format reply. We investigated the problem and described why it occurred. You can opened HTML source of the page and saw that MooTools library is loaded by map extension or check extension's code.

Yes. GMaps is disabled on this site but enabled on another and they don't conflict there. So, MooTools is not the answer.

Layer Slider conflicts with two more extensions - PRI Animation (animation works only on scroll) and Animate It (animation doesn't work at all) when ARI Layer slider is on at lexic-on.ru/ru and lexic-on.ru/en

But again everything works fine with all the same extensions and settings at <http://79.165.111.198/lexicon>

Javascript code of pranimation plugin is executed before javascript code of the slider (the slider calculates width and height of container element to adapt it for screen size) and pranimation can't correctly calculate height of the slider and doesn't execute animation. The plugin supposes the elements ("Why us" and etc.) are located in non-visible area. It executes animation only for visible elements and re-check visibility on scroll event.

Add the following CSS rule to a site template CSS file and clean browser's cache:

.xslider {height:1px;}

It should help.

Thanx. It helped. But this solution is temporary because the slider loads slower then other modules which results in the page jumps down after the slider has loaded. It is impossible to specify fixed xslider height (i've specified 350px instead of 1px) because it is responsive and the height is changing all the time.
