I am planning to purchase the plugin, but only after I can make this work in mobile device (2 image side by side).

I already try the above solution:

```
.asq-theme.asq-theme-buzzfeed .quiz-question-has-image-answer .answer-col-2 .quiz-question-answer-holder {flex-basis: 50% !important}
```

But it is not working. In mobile device, it is still the same as usual.

I try this solution: @media (max-width:768px) {

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```
.asq-theme .quiz-question-answer-image IMG {max-width:150px!important}
}
```

But it does not make the image placed 2 side by side, it is just the same (one image per row), but just smaller image.

Can you kindly help to recheck whether the correct CSS is still valid in the latest version of the plugin?

Note that I am still using the free version, but once this got resolved, I am planning to upgrade to pro version.

I have checked the page source, the correct CSS is already loaded that already contain the above solution, but when we try using mobile (or using mobile simulator) now, the quiz is coming back to the wrong layout.
