Actually l've looked into the problem a little more. It appears that fancy lightbox will correctly display the #page= Ending when it is converting a PDF from an external site, but not a Local PDF file. So it would be nice if you could look into this and let people know why that is the case.

But in the absence of that, I would like to be able to disable it either on a specific page or for a specific URL. So if that is possible, I would appreciate any instructions for how to do that.
