We checked everything on our server and contacted Mailerlite and can't find a reason why this would be happening. Though lately everything is fine and we only had one record "lost" since we turned on debugging.
My question is: is it possible that PHP version is giving us troubles? we checked cURL seting, DNS setting and logs and everything works fine, we found no issues in logs and server connects to Mailerlite without a problem, Mailerlite support also found nothing wrong, no specific records in the logs pointing to a possible problem. They advised us to contact you again, maybe you have any other ideas/advice?
