AriMagnifier..... here is my situation:

I have a directory under the root called images/article-images

In this directory I have 2 pics, com-large.jpg and com-small.jpg

I have an article, which contains ONLY this code:

```

I cant see anything!.....

The parameter settings on the arimagnifier plugin (which IS enabled) are:

Thumbnail Width = 350

Thumbnail Height = 200

Generate thumbnail = YES

What am I doing wrong???? I am having problems with other plugins as well, but if I can get this one going, I am sure I can get the others.

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The image with the yellow background is actually the larger image (com-large.jpg), and its dimensions are 802 x 576. The black & white image (com-small.jpg) has dimensions of 250 X 180.

As you can see, the larger image is showing up actually smaller than the small image.....
